Bargaining Your Second Contract: Look, Listen, Communicate

As negotiations get under way for your second contract, pay close attention to information coming from the negotiators you have selected to represent your workplace. It becomes more important with each passing day.

The Sitka Contract Negotiation Committee (CNC) will be meeting with the City of Sitka numerous times in the coming months. They will look to you as their constituents for support of them as a committee and as a team. Besides offering support to the Sitka CNC, you can pass along important information as it becomes available, and as negotiations unfurl. Getting the latest word from the bargaining table out to your colleagues on the progress and content of negotiations helps not only yourself, but aids your negotiation team by having a well informed union membership for the Sitka CNC to represent.

Let your representative to the Sitka CNC know what the buzz is in the workplace among members and any whispers from management that you hear after each session of negotiations. That gives the Sitka CNC an idea how members feel and how management is reacting about the progress and direction of negotiations. This will enable your Sitka CNC to adjust their strategy at the negotiation table accordingly.

An open line of communication flowing in both directions between the Sitka CNC and Sitka members will serve to make the goals set by the Sitka CNC all the more readily attainable.
