## AFSCME INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION DELEGATE NOTICE OF NOMINATION

**ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 members are hereby notified that nominations are now being accepted for delegate positions for AFSCME's 39<sup>th</sup> International Convention.**

### GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING THE ELECTION

Article 7 of the ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 Constitution and Policy 22.00.000 of the ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 Policies and Procedures (P&P's) spell out the details of the election process. These documents are available on the Union website at [www.afscmelocal52.org](http://www.afscmelocal52.org) or through each of the ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 business offices.

1. All nominations must be made by Nomination Petition. A copy of ASEA/AFSCME Local 52's standardized nominating petition is included with this notice. Petitions for the AFSCME International Convention Delegate Positions must include signatures of 10 members in good standing. Additional petitions may be obtained from any Union office or the Union's website. You may, however, prepare and submit your own form as long as it contains all the required information.
2. Fill out the Nomination Petition Form and return to ASEA/AFSCME Local 52. For the petition to be valid, it MUST be signed by 10 members in good standing..
3. To be eligible for election to the position of delegate, a candidate must be employed by the State of Alaska and must be a member in good standing.
4. *A candidate may submit a statement of the candidate's personal qualifications for the office sought. A candidate's personal qualifications may include **education, experience, accomplishments, and goals for office** (22.B.8 of the P&P's).*
5. Nominations must be mailed, faxed or delivered to the ASEA/AFSCME LOCAL 52 ELECTION COMMITTEE, in care of any ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 office, **BY NOON on March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Please call to verify that nomination petition has been received for the Election Committee by Skye McRoberts at 277-5200 or 1-800-478-2732.** Union Staff will date stamp all Nomination Petition Forms on the front.
8. Candidates have the right to have official observers (other than themselves) present when the ballots are counted.
9. The AFSCME Convention Delegate candidate who receives the highest number of votes will be the Convention Delegate #2 position. The candidate who receives the second highest number of votes will be the Convention Delegate #4 position. The candidate who receives the third highest vote will be the Convention Delegate #6 position, and the remaining candidates in descending order of votes will occupy the remaining delegate positions. (Convention Delegates Position #1, #3, and #5 will be occupied by the President, Secretary and Treasurer of ASEA. See Article 14 of the current ASEA Constitution.)

1. **FEBRUARY 23, 2010** - Notice of Nominations mailed out to members.
2. **MARCH 24, 2010 NOON** - Deadline for receipt of Nomination Petition Forms
3. **APRIL 7, 2010** - Ballots mailed to members.
4. **MAY 13, 2010 - THIS IS THE "ELECTION DATE"** (Ballots Counted) Ballots MUST BE RECEIVED BY 8:30 a.m. on this date. Only ballots returned through the U.S. Mail will be counted. Counting will commence following receipt of the ballots by the Election Committee.
