ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 Constitution Article 6.07.B.3 provides that the constitution may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members voting in favor of a proposed amendment in a mail ballot referendum. Any such amendment must be submitted to the State Executive Board with signatures from at least one hundred (100) members in good standing of the union. The same timetable that applies to the annual nomination and election of officers shall be applicable to the submission of such proposed amendments. A statement explaining the purpose for the proposed amendment, which may not exceed two hundred fifty (250) words in length, must be submitted with the proposed amendment. The proposed amendment and the explanatory statement shall be mailed to the members with a ballot in the same mailing used for the annual election of officers. In accord with that provision, the following members hereby support the above proposed amendment.
