Dear Brother Duncan:

We have completed our review of the proposed amendment to the ASEA Constitution that would create a Standing Committee for Class I members. This amendment has been approved, with the addition of language that describes the purpose of the standing committee and defines the size of the committee, how members are appointed and the frequency of committee meetings. The new language we have added is based on the statement that accompanied the ballot mailed to the membership. This language, together with your inclusion of the balance of that statement's proposals in the ASEA's Policies and Procedures, will ensure that the intent of amendment is met.

Enclosed are two copies of the local constitution, as amended, with my signature of approval on the final page. Should the local adopt additional amendments to this constitution, please submit them for approval after the membership has voted on them.
