

2024-2025 Academic Scholarships

How much is the scholarship award?

Four scholarships of \$1500 each will be awarded for the 2024-2025 academic year, to be used at any accredited institution.

Who is Eligible?

Members in good standing of the Midnight Sun Chapter of ASEA/AFSCME Local 52; their current spouses; or their dependents (aged 25 years or younger). *

How to Apply

- 1) You must submit your essay and a completed application to the ASEA MSC office by 4 pm on Friday, May 31st, 2024. Essays that are not accompanied by a completed application will be disqualified from consideration. **
- 2) You must be accepted to, enrolled in, or attending an accredited post-secondary or vocational/technical institution by the end of the first week of classes for Fall 2024. ***
