How much is the scholarship award?

TWO scholarships of \$1500 each will be awarded for the 2022-2023 academic year, to be used at any accredited institution.

Who is Eligible?

Members in good standing of the Midnight Sun Chapter of ASEA/AFSCME Local 52; their current spouses; or their dependents (aged 25 years or younger). *

How to Apply

- 1) You must submit your essay and a completed application to the ASEA MSC office by 4 pm on Friday, April 15, 2022. Essays that are not accompanied by a completed application will be disqualified from consideration. **
- 2) You must be accepted to, enrolled in, and attending an accredited post-secondary or vocational/technical institution by the end of the first week of classes for Fall 2022. **

2022-2023 SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY QUESTIONS

(Please ONLY answer one question)

- 1. What do you think is the greatest threat to our Union's strength today?
 What could you do or have you done to mitigate this threat?
- 2. Tell us about your most important role model, and why you look up to that individual? ** (Avoid mentioning first and last names of people who are personal family members or individuals in your personal circle in the essay. Applicants may use names of celebrities and public/historical figures). **
- 3. Since the COVID-19 pandemic, it has been difficult to interact and engage with members. What are some ways to increase participation with the members while adhering to safety measures and protocols?

Note: Essays will be judged less on length than on content, spelling, grammar, and how directly and completely the answer reflects the question. Personal examples and source citations are encouraged. The expected length is approximately 500 words, but there is no penalty for longer essays.
