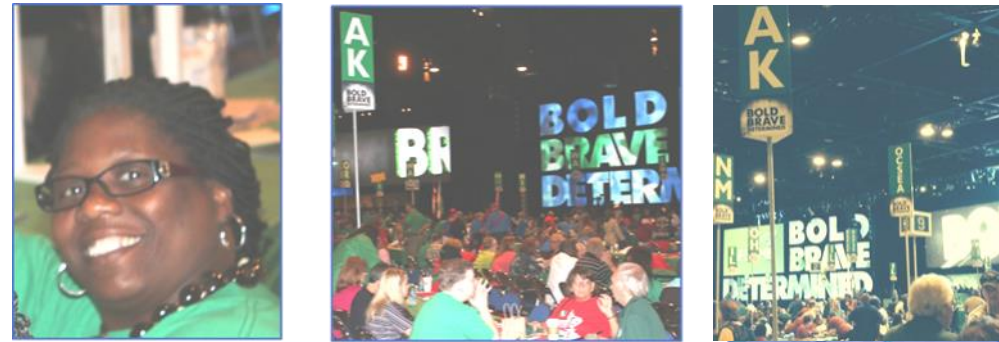

Take Advantage Of The Annual Health Fairs

They're Free, Fun and Good For You!

Health Fairs offer four (4) FREE preventive care lab tests to ASEA Health Trust members and covered dependents ages 18 and over. Screenings can help you learn about your health and detect potential problems early on. Test results will be sent directly to you. Remember to send a copy to your health care professional to review and file with your medical records. Also take advantage of free seasonal flu vaccines available to those 9 years or older (in Juneau you must be 13 or older). Save time at the Fair by preregistering for tests at coalitionhealthfair.org

Meet Coalition Health Center Staff!

Representatives from the Coalition Health Center will be at the Anchorage Health Fair. Stop by to learn more about the Center and to schedule an appointment to review your lab test results! They treat all kinds of conditions and illnesses, monitor diabetes and high blood pressure, write prescriptions, provide preventive services and physical exams and much more. You only pay a \$10 copay per visit (\$0 for preventive care). You don't have to meet the annual deductible and the Center doesn't charge more than the Health Plan allows for office visits or lab services.
