15th Biennial Convention Important Dates

January 24: Chapter Delegate List, Credential Forms and Proposed Constitutional Amendments and Resolutions must be received at Anchorage Headquarters by close of business (5:00 p.m.)

February 3: Delegate Information Packets mailed to Certified Delegates and Alternates. Packet includes travel/parking, lodging and Union business leave information and hotel and travel forms.

February 19: Travel forms due to ASEA Headquarters
February 24: Convention Packets mailed to Delegates

March 12: Delegate Education Training

March 13 - 14: Parliamentary Training / Convention Committee - Work Sessions

March 15 - 16: 15th Biennial Convention - Business Session
