RALLY AT TRUMP HOTEL – AFSCME WORKPLACE ACTION PLAN

More than 2,000 AFSCME delegates braved the +105° heat and took to the streets to stand in solidarity with Culinary Workers demanding a fair contract at the Trump International Hotel Las Vegas.

On Thursday, President Saunders announced that Donald Trump's Las Vegas hotel had agreed to pay two workers a total of \$11,200 to avoid going to trial over a labor complaint filed in March by the NLRB.
