

Buffalo Chapter Donates To Delta Junction **Trails Association**

ASEA's Buffalo Chapter has donated \$1,000 to the Delta Junction Trails Association's Bluff Cabin Trail Restoration Project. The Bluff Cabin Trail is both a historic and a current recreational trail. The Trails Association plans to upgrade the trail for year-round hiking, skiing, snow machining and ATV use. This will provide access to the historic Bluff Cabin, fishing at Bluff Cabin Lake and a wilderness experience. It will also provide an improved pathway for wildland fire suppression in the Delta Area, a point of interest for many Buffalo Chapter members.

Like in many areas of the state, development closes historic trails as communities grow. Delta's Trail Bluff Cabin Restoration Project will assist the preservation of this trail and provide a legacy for the community. The Association needed to raise \$25,000 as their match for a \$100,000 grant. The Buffalo Chapter's donation was a significant part of the match. A sign recognizing major donors will be placed at the trailhead.
