Key Deadline

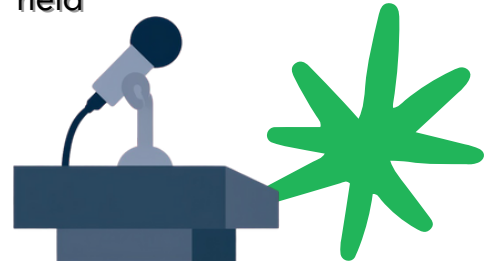
