ASEA GGU Members voted to ratify the 2025-2028 contract by 95%. The GGUCNC thanks ASEA members for their incredible participation, engagement, and support during this incredibly difficult negotiation cycle. A summary of COLA increases* for ASEA GGU Employees:

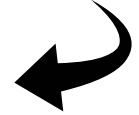
- Year 1: **Three percent (3%) raise** + \$2,500 lump sum**
- Year 2: Another **three percent (3%) raise** + \$2,000 lump sum
- Year 3: A minimum **five percent (5%) raise**

*COLA increases apply to all bargaining unit employees.

**Lump sum increases apply to all permanent full-time employees, regardless of probationary or seasonal status

SALARY STUDY LAWSUIT UPDATE

After mounting pressure, and several drafts later, the elusive salary study was published on the Dept. of Administration's website in early April. In May, Judge Wheelles denied ASEA's request for a preliminary injunction. In July, we were in front of judge Wheelles again to present evidence that the public, including ASEA, has the right to see previous versions of draft salary studies that were produced Segal Group. We hope to have another update by August.
