QUICK UPDATES ON CHALLENGES IN COURT:

- * Salary Study: Briefs have been filed and we are awaiting a decision on the case in the Superior Court. This case will likely make its way to the Alaska Supreme Court for final resolution.
- * DPA Outsourcing Grievance and Award Challenge: Oral arguments were held in March in Anchorage in Superior Court on whether the arbitration award should stand. We are awaiting the court's decision.

NOPP UPDATE:

While a settlement in the NOPP class-action grievance was reached, delays persist in the issuance of NOPP responses. We recently learned that the NOPP portal has been discontinued from the State of Alaska's website. If you file a NOPP, please make sure to save a copy and notify your union representative if you disagree with the response.
