Re: Notice of 2022 Alaska AFL-CIO Biennial Convention - August 24-25, 2022, Sheraton Hotel and Spa, Anchorage, AK

In accordance with the Alaska AFL-CIO Constitution, a convention of the Alaska AFL-CIO shall be scheduled biennially in even numbered years. Therefore, the 2022 Alaska AFL-CIO Biennial Convention will be held at the Sheraton Hotel and Spa in Anchorage, Alaska on August 24-25, 2022. In addition to the two full days of convention, the Alaska AFL-CIO will hold a pre-convention work session on August 23, 2022, to prepare resolutions for the full body.

According to Article XII, Representation and Voting, Section 1, affiliated local unions in good standing shall be entitled to representation and votes in conventions of the Alaska AFL-CIO based upon the average number of members upon whom per capita tax has been paid in accordance with the provisions of this article. The number of credential forms you are receiving is equal to the number of delegates for which your union is eligible.

The deadline to return your credentials and fees is August 14th, 2022. It would be appreciated if you could return them to us by this date or sooner if possible. You can mail these credentials to us at the address listed below. If you need a room, we have a block of rooms reserved. You should do this as soon as possible as the room block fills up fast. You can book by calling the Sheraton Anchorage Hotel and Spa at 907-276-8700 and referencing "AFL CIO Conference 2022" when booking. The room rate is \$229 per night.
